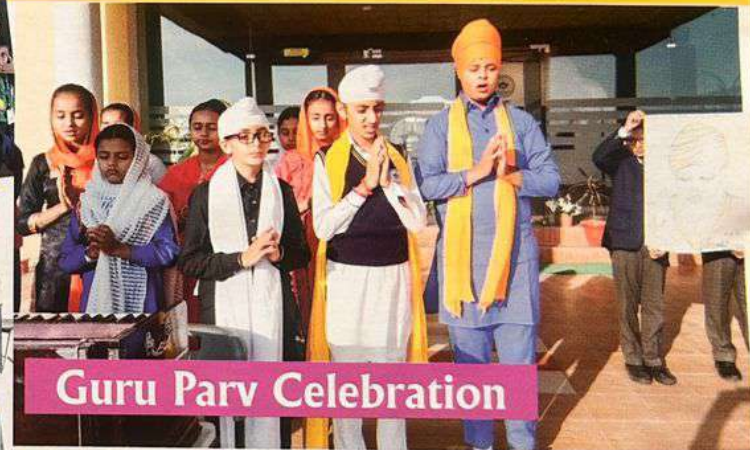
Diwali

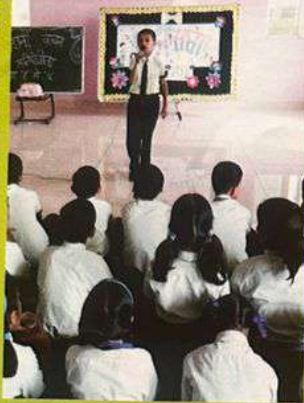

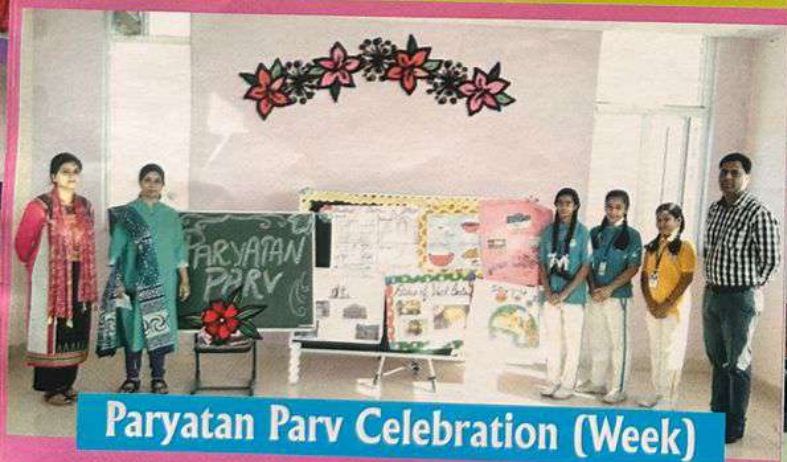
Hindi Diwas Celebration

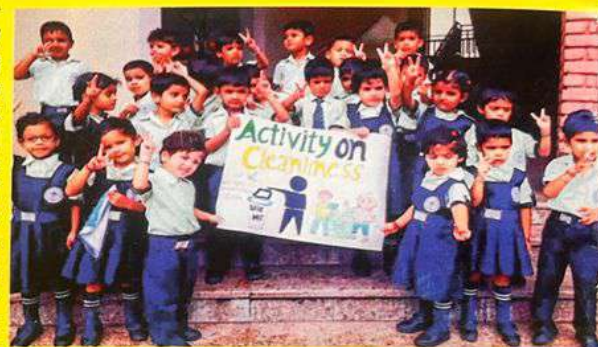
